About

This data collection, a joint project between NHS England and NHS Improvement and the National Cancer Registration and Analysis Service (NCRAS) based at Public Health England, supports the production of a national quality of life (QoL) metric for cancer.

The data is sourced from a voluntary patient survey; in the first year, the survey will be sent to breast, prostate and colorectal cancer patients at 18 months post diagnosis. In time, the survey will be expanded to include all cancer patients 18 months post diagnosis.

NCRAS will supply the patient cohort to NHS England and NHS Improvement who will issue the survey to patients, via Quality Heath, in accordance with Regulation 2 of the Health Service (Control of Patient Information) Regulations 2002. The results of the survey will be fed back to the NCRAS to support the production of the QoL metric for cancer.
